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- 1) Manuscripts should be typewritten with double-spacing (at least 6 mm between lines) on letter size (8-1/2 x 11 inches) or A4 size (21 x 29.5 cm) papers with ample margins [at least 1 inch (2.54cm)] on all four sides, with no indented paragraphs.
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The components of a manuscript should be 1) title page, 2) abstract, 3) introduction, 4) materials and methods, 5) results, 6) discussion, 7) acknowledgments, 8) reference, 9) tables, and 10) figure legends. The complete manuscript should be arranged in that order.

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Beginning on page 3: Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion, Acknowledgments, References, Table and Figure legends.
